

Reconditioned Bow Exchange Form

Schmitt Music is pleased to offer a program for used and worn student bows. This “exchange” program is more cost efficient than a typical bow rehair and allows the director to take advantage of replacing “Lost Bows” collecting dust in the storage room. Qualifying models are Glasser Standard Fiberglass, Eastman K. Holtz Fiberglass and Artino Carbon Graphite BF-39 series bows. Glasser, the company that patented the world’s first Fiberglass bow, offers students a good alternative to inexpensive wood bows, since they are more durable and will not warp. Our standard Fiberglass bows feature a half-lined bow frog with metal under-slide and an imitation three-part button. The Standard Fiberglass bows come in a satin black finish, have genuine unbleached white horsehair, and a leatherette grip.

The most important bow a player will ever use is the first one. A beginning player should not have to make a large investment in his or her first bow. At the same time, it is unrealistic to expect an inexperienced player to excel if he or she is forced to play with poorly balanced, weak, or warped bow.

K.Holtz PG bows require no compromise - they are designed with beginning players’ specific needs and budgets in mind. These strong, well-balanced, attractive bows produce a smooth, clear sound without a lot of physical effort from the player. And with K.Holtz PG bows, players can invest their efforts in improving their playing without having to invest a lot of money in their bows.



The BF-39 Composite Bows are targeted at rental outfits and student model instruments. Made from a high quality carbon graphite stick, the BF-39 bows are well-balanced and of average weight. The imitation whalebone winding and attractive pearl inlay add a touch of elegance to a quality low-cost option. The BF-39 Composite Bow is available for violin, viola, cello, and both French and German grip bass bows. All bows are available in fractional sizes from 1/4 to full size, with violin and viola bows also available in 1/8 size.
